INTRODUCTION AND HISTORY

Foundation Stone of Cadet College Kohat was laid by Governor West Pakistan, Malik Amir Muhammad Khan on 19 April 1964. The first entry of 58 cadets was inducted in 8th class in April 1965 in Jinnah House. Lt Col (Retd) Faizullah Khan Khattak was the founder Principal of this premier residential academic institution. Although the College does not prepare cadets purely for military career, yet in 1971 out of 107 cadets, 95 were selected for Commission in Defence Forces-a record percentage of success achieved by any single educational institution in the country. However, a large number of cadets also opt for professions such as medical, engineering, business management and civil services etc. Ever since its inception, the College has displayed outstanding results in SSC and HSSC Board Examinations. The College has bagged a number of Presidential Awards for academic excellence besides excelling in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.

LOCATION

Cadet College Kohat is situated at the junction of Kohat Rawalpindi Road and National Highway, approximately 8 KM from Kohat city. Kohat-Pindi Railway line passes through it.

CAMPUS

The College covers an area of 144 acres with 20 lush green playing-fields, 8 Football, 7 Hockey, 6 Volleyball grounds, 6 Basketball cemented courts, 3 Cricket-pitches, a beautiful sports stadium, 2 Squash Courts, a well equipped indoor Gymnasium, a Swimming Pool, a Riding Club, 2 Recreation Parks, Staff Colony, Shopping Centre, a Utility Store and a Post Office. A beautiful mosque right in the middle of the campus adds to the serenity of the atmosphere. The carefully maintained orchards, flowerbeds and vegetation, provide a refreshing hue to the visitors. Six tubewells ensure supply of water both for irrigation and drinking purposes.

COLLEGE ADMINISTRATION

Cadet College Kohat (CCK) is under the control and management of Board of Governors (BOG). The Honourable Chief Minister KPK is the Patron-in-Chief and General Officer Commanding 9 Division Kohat is the Chairman of the BOG. The Principal CCK is responsible for College administration.

STAFF

The College has a psychologist and qualified teaching staff, divided into various departments,

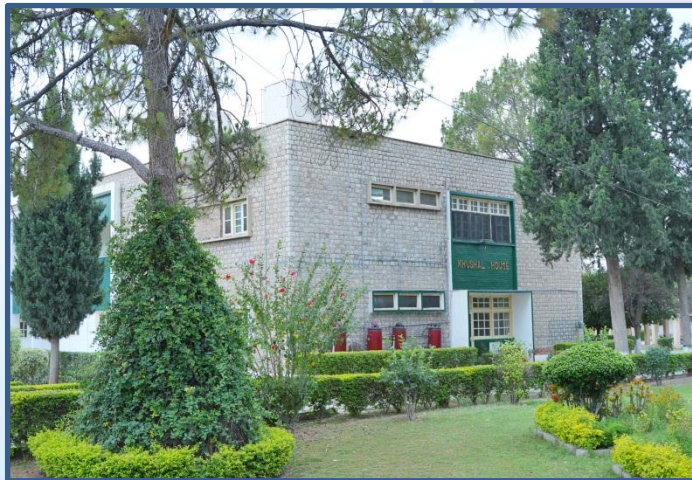


each headed by a senior member. The Army Staff is headed by the Adjutant of the rank of Captain / Major and is responsible for military and physical training of cadets. The College has an elaborate administrative setup for smooth functioning of routine activities.

CURRICULUM AND SYSTEM OF EDUCATION

The College follows the syllabus laid down by the KPK Textbook Board, Peshawar. The medium of instructions is English. The subjects taught in the College at SSC level are Urdu, English, Islamiyat, Pakistan Studies, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Computer Science and Biology.

The College offers Pre-Medical and Pre-Engineering courses for Intermediate classes. The laboratories are equipped with the latest apparatus.



Class tests and terminal examinations are held at regular intervals. Cadets' progress reports are assessed and complete record of their academic performance and overall conduct is sent to the parents at the end of each term. A cadet failing twice in the same class is no longer retained in the College

HOUSES / HOSTELS

Cadets are accommodated in 7 Houses, each with a capacity of 95 cadets. Every House is being looked after by a House Master, assisted by House Tutor, Military Staff and House Bearer. Moreover, 4-5 teachers are also affiliated with each House to help the cadets academically.



CADETS' MESSES

The College has 3 Dining facilities. Messing officer assisted by his staff is charged with keeping the Messes upto the highest standard of services.

SPORTS



Sports form an integral part of training of cadets. Regular Inter-House, Seniors and Juniors Competitions, both indoor and outdoor, (Hockey, Football, Cricket, Basketball, Athletics, Table Tennis, Badminton, Shooting) are arranged under the supervision of qualified coaches. Annual sports fixtures are also arranged with the sister institutions.

PHYSICAL TRAINING

Games, Sports and PT/Drill are compulsory for cadets. The College has a spacious and well equipped Indoor Gymnasium, gymnastic equipment and obstacle course for physical training and indoor games / sports.





CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Inter-House Urdu, English debates, Essay Writing, Qirat / Naat and Quiz Competitions are held regularly to put the cadets through a variety of co-curricular activities. Parliamentary debate is also arranged on alternate Friday in culture period.

COLLEGE HOSPITAL

The College has a well equipped ten bedded Hospital under the supervision of Senior Medical Officer, assisted by 2 dispensers. The hospital has its own ambulance. Cadets with serious ailments are referred to C.M.H Kohat.

EDUCATIONAL VISITS AND EXCURSIONS

The College attaches great importance to educational visits and excursions. Visits are arranged to various institutions and places of historical importance.

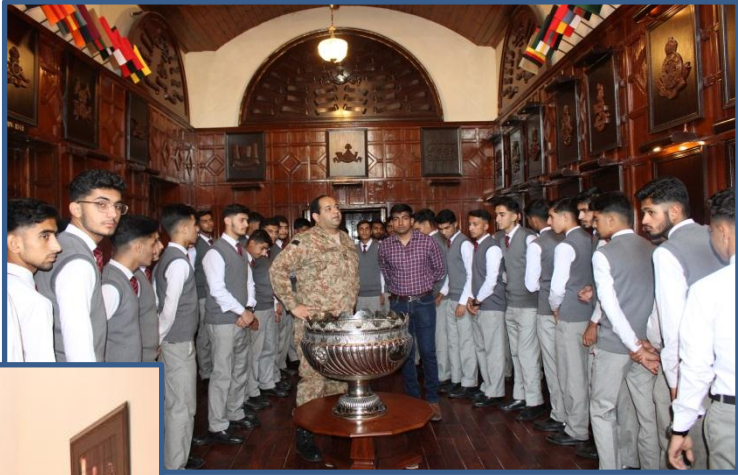
CLUBS AND SOCIETIES

DIGITAL LIBRARY AND AUDIO-VISUAL AIDS

In order to equip the cadets with modern techniques for acquisition of knowledge and learning, a modern digital library has been setup in the newly constructed multimedia block under the supervision of a qualified librarian. The library contains more than 30,000 books on a variety of subjects besides E-Books containing thousands of Urdu/English Magazines, Journals, Periodicals, Digests etc.



LANGUAGE LABORATORY

The College has established a Language Laboratory with latest equipment, through donation by Admiral Muhammad Asif Sandhila (Ex Cadet), Chief of the Naval Staff, to improve the English speaking ability of cadets.



LITERARY AND CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

A compulsory period is reserved for cultural and literary activities on Fridays. The topics for junior and senior classes are published in the Weekly College Order. Cadets are encouraged to express their views on various topics to build their confidence. Parliamentary debate is also arranged in this period.





MULTIMEDIA BLOCK

Multimedia Block consists of one fully equipped Lecture Hall, One Computer laboratory equipped with 30 computers, printer and scanner, Two Class Rooms and One Multimedia Office. Computer Science is being thought as a Regular Subject substituting Biology, Computer Literacy classes are compulsory for cadets of VIII to X in which various software packages and programming languages are taught.

RELIGIOUS INSTRUCTIONS

Honesty and truthfulness form the corner stone of our religious teaching. Religious instructions are explicitly interwoven into the daily routine of the College.



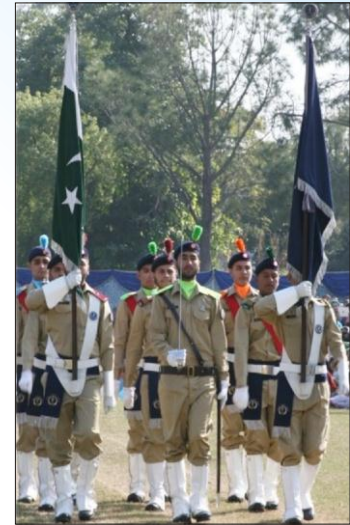


COLLEGE MAGAZINE

ADMISSION

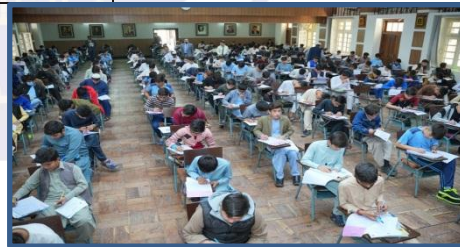
Admission is granted in 8th Class purely on merit on the basis of cumulative results of Written Examination, Interview and Medical Test conducted by the College. A candidate should be between 12 and 14 years on 31 March of the year of admission and must have passed 7th Class at that time. However, age waiver of 6 months is granted to Hafiz-e-Quran only. Some available seats are also filled in 11th Class under Additional Dues Scheme on merit.

- (4). Correct spellings.
- (5). Change sentences into interrogative and negative forms.
- (6). Genders, Antonyms / Synonyms, Numbers.
- (7). Writing Essay / Paragraph, Letter / Application / Dialogue or building a story from a given outline.
- (8). Translation from Urdu into English and Vice Versa.
- (9). Change of Voice and Narration.
- (10). Answers to questions from a given paragraph.

B. Mathematics (Marks: 100)

- (1) Union and Intersection of sets, De Morgan's law.
- (2) Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division of common, compound & decimal fractions.
- (3) Square root of decimal and common fractions, approximate square roots, word problems of square root.

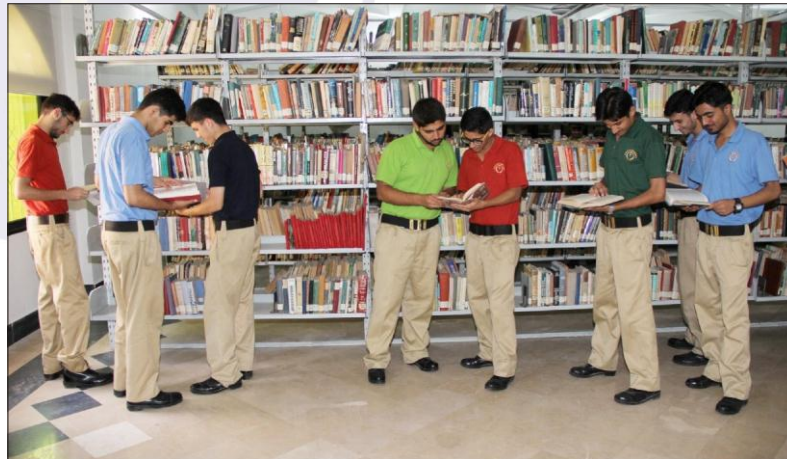
